



Franz Valley Rally

The Redwood Region of PCA presents an entry-level Monte Carlo open to all cars.

All roads are paved, public, and in good condition. A short break is included in the route.

All turns will be clearly identified in the route instructions with cumulative miles from the start of the rally and interval miles from the prior route instruction. Diagrams of the intersections are included for all turns. There are no traps.

Math calculations will not be necessary. There are no assigned speeds; you may drive any safe and legal speed you wish.

All checkpoints will be identified in your route instructions along with the time you are due. The strategy is to arrive a little early and wait in the pull-off area before the checkpoint, then pass the checkpoint at your assigned time for a zero. A smartphone is required to record your checkpoints times via a free app.

A working odometer will be required to identify the turns and checkpoints. If you will be using a GPS app as your odometer, you will need a second device for the GPS checkpoint app.
