- * Database Chair (Eric Anderson)
 - No progress on database. What shall we do with the online-only rallyist info?
 - Expand invitation to all our database members? Or trc-events?
- * Publicity (TBD):
 - Need a new Publicity Chair.
 - Al without an owner: Modernize duties listed in Operating Procedures.
 - Mailing ASAP. Eric gonna draft postcards.
 - Dean should announce August's rallye to trc-events. Mention Twitter sign-up.
- * Webmaster:
 - Migration in progress, off Steve Watt's server to IONOS.
 - Ric switching target from IONOS to DreamHost. TRC won't have to pay while using Ric's hosting package. 3 years available at \$3 per month.

- * Extend TRC's computer scoring program for A/B rallyes
 - Glen agreed to look into the practicality of extending TRC's computer scoring program for A/B rallyes, likely rewriting it in Python or something more modern.
 - The online access is down / missing. Glen asked Nick where the sources are.
 - Dean may have a copy on the (old) TRC computers, if needed. Dean checked.
 - Lots of talk about how to get rallyists to give us machine-readable information.
 - OK to put source on a "public" git hub (only we can modify the code).

NEW BUSINESS

- * TRC rallye history
 - TRC Wiki has Past TRC Rallyes through 1981-2011.
 - TRC Results page has results from 2003 through now.
 - Someone should build the union, even if some info is missing.
 - This would allow us to celebrate our 500th event, for example.
 - Dave to talk to Ric, and one of them will do it (eventually).
- * Survey about online rallyes
 - Dean thinks it could wait for December's online rallye.
 - Ken is drumming up remote RMs.
- * Considering moving business meetings. We wondered last month about early Third Wednesday evenings. Ric said that wouldn't work for him.
 - Tabled for now
 - Ed A/I to see when Ric could meet (if he would join our meetings).
 - Ric will send a Doodle poll: what works for each of us. [DONE after meeting]

- Pay annual insurance fee for 28 members (after Cris gives the permember amount).
- Contact Jeffrey Martin to get him started writing a rallye for 2022.
- Update Publicity wiki page or send Dean info on announcing to So Cal Facebook group.
- Dave is "Plan B" if Darin is too busy to write an online Toy Rallye for 2021.
- Unify TRC Wiki's Past TRC Rallyes list and our modern results or get Ric to do it.
- Dave, as Treasurer, to attempt to complete the applicable portions of Dave to fill out and submit IRS Form 990-N for IRS and 199-N for California, as time allows. Ric may be able to help.

- Pending: Deliver equipment (parts) to Ed. [DONE after meeting]
- Deliver old rallyes from Darin to Eric.
