**Treasurer** (Dave): \$5,274.01 at B of A; \$5,349.01 total. Donations to Toys

for Tots were made, \$270 total (gross revenue from rallye of 170, plus 50 from TRC directly, and 50 from Lotus club.) Someone noted that we should get more petty cash for the February rallye for membership drive

(though PayPal might alleviate that some, but the

convenience fee is somewhat inconvenient). (Suggestion from multiple people to call it the

"MemberShip Drive" Rallye.)

Action item for Registration desk staff for the next few rallyes; track who paid how to see the feasibility of getting away from cash. Cris and Dave to bring up with Eric when possible.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

#### Insurance

- New renewal annual fee with K&K is not known. Last year's Annual fee was about \$9 / active member (37 members). Combine those and send to ESCA for 2024 (this is overdue for the year, so it's not 2025) Calendar year. We also pay \$114 per event.
- A/I: Get number of active members (after February 1 rallye), Cris pays the bill, and then Dave reimburses Cris.
- It would be useful to have a fairly solid list of in-person rallyes by February 28, when we renew the policy.

### Awards Chair (Eric Anderson, not present):

Database (formerly Membership) Chair (Eric Anderson, not present):

- Eric has ideas to improve online registration and paying for IRL rallyes.
- QR code on score sheet or GIs that lets people enter their car number and return (giving us their email address).

### Publicity (Kat King):

- Discussion about emails being sent out more frequently to remind people or in case the previous email got forgotten in their inbox.
  - Social media supplements this.
  - Create calendar of events that kicks out an ics? (This will be coordinated offline.)
- Ric and Kat met, went through and did updates for the YouTube channel and made a new banner. More stuff in process but they made good progress. ("A banner day." -Dean)
  - Youtube needs videos.
  - If TikTok is going down we can host shorts.
    - Looking for ride-alongs and rallye schools, etc.
    - Shorts and videos can be made with voice overs and pictures as well.
- Find a way to appeal to people that can't spend a day finding out if they like rallyes.
  - Dean discussed running an indoor Rallye at Mt. View Target. (new for June)
     Unlikely to happen at Target since the Board felt permissions might be problematic, but maybe a mall (Great Mall?) No ownership of this at the moment.
  - Flash Rallye as a 10 RI video series. Will begin to work with Jeff on this. Have talked about gimmicks, but no real draft yet.
  - ZBS corporation videos Ruby the Galactic Gumshoe audio vignettes.

- Check out Pirate rallye school POV video with voice over.
- Several day events w/ checkpoints as office hours, rallye across a week.
  - Multiple people agree the format is a good idea, shelve for a different online rallye.
- How can a TikTok style quick video attract rallyists? Need something fun and quick.
  - Pirate Day rallye school may help.
    - Kat coming up with a script
  - OR codes link to them?

### Webmaster — (Ric Goldman)

- WordPress migration delayed but should work on it more in January.
- Zoom link for TRC non-business is the email from Ric on November 5th.
  - o Remember to "End Meeting for All" when done.
  - This link is mainly for prechecks. Do not use this link for checkpoints and awards for online rallyes; that Zoom link is created on an as-needed basis.
