#### Insurance

- Golden Gate Lotus Club paid for the insurance for December and donated extra money (\$50) for the charity.
- Insurance certs are being issued for both December and February
- February has not been paid yet. Cris to do this in January...
- New renewal annual fee with K&K is not known. (Last year's Annual fee paid (114 dollars (event), plus (possibly, to be confirmed) about \$9 / active member (37 members). Combine those and send to ESCA) for 2024 Calendar year.)
- A/I: Get number of active members (after February 1 rallye), Cris pays the bill, and then Dave reimburses Cris.
