CM Marker Parkers

From left to right

- 1. Hammer tacker on painting pole. Staples CM to wooden poles
- 2. Spare painting pole because
- 3. Hammer tacker on longer painting pole
- 4. Weed picker on painting pole. Good for prying out staples, also helpful in pushing up CM on board on concrete poles.
- 5. Painting roller with "claw" on painting pole. Roller to help with CM's with tape loop on back, sticking tape to metal pole or other surface. Claw, use to rip down staled or taped markers. Used to push up CM on board and pull them down. Sponge block to protect car interior from claw while transporting.







CM Box with boards and bungees

Boards are about 9x12, attach CM with staples or tape, use (usually one) bungee to secure to metal or concrete light pole,


use "claw" to push up into position.

- Some use a loop of duct tape to attach the CM to board, when removed, tape leaves some adhesive residue, be nice if they were wiped down with some Goo-Gone to clear tape residue.
- Stapling CM to board is the preferred method. Key to success is to staple on a solid surface (not your thigh while seated) to get decent penetration. After recovering board and removing CM, please remove staples with needle-nose pliers.
