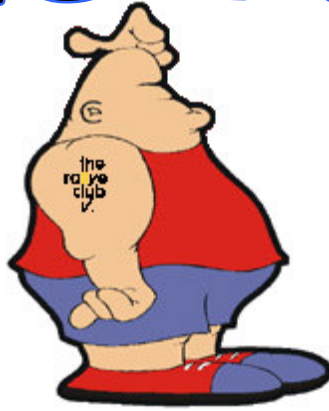

A rallye is not a race, but a puzzle where The Game Piece is your car and The Game Board is the road.

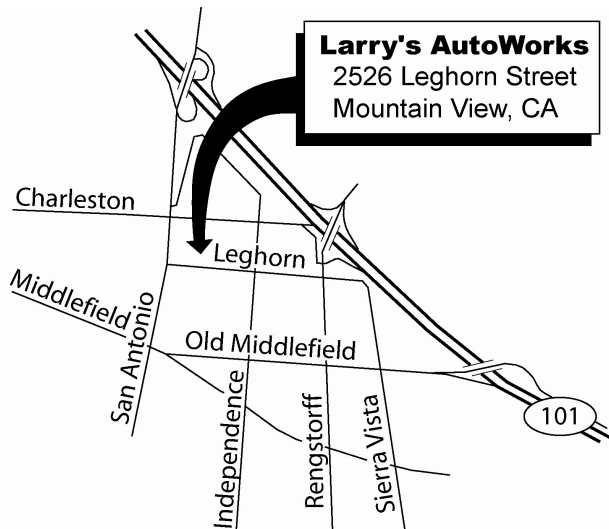
