What's a rallye?

A Road Rallye is not a race but a test of your ability to follow instructions over a pre-determined route. By catching the "tricks" and "gimmicks," you'll find coursemarkers. The more good coursemarkers you find; the better your score. This rallye was originally presented in 1989. We hope you find it to be as much fun now as it was then.



From the Story:

When RI 4 or 9 comes into effect, you encounter the White Rabbit. His hurrying and chronic lateness are legendary, and they rub off on you: when one of these RIs is in effect and you come to a place where you could validly complete that RI, perform the action which would complete the RI the next time you encounter an intersection, and then consider the RI to be completed. 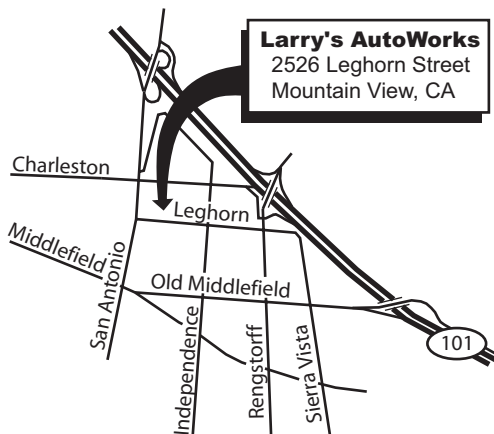
