## What is a rallye?

## Find the Cases, Earn the Points

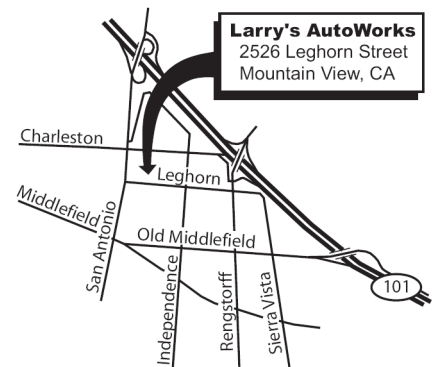
**Awards: 6 classes (First Timer, Beginner, Novice, Senior, Expert, & Master)**
