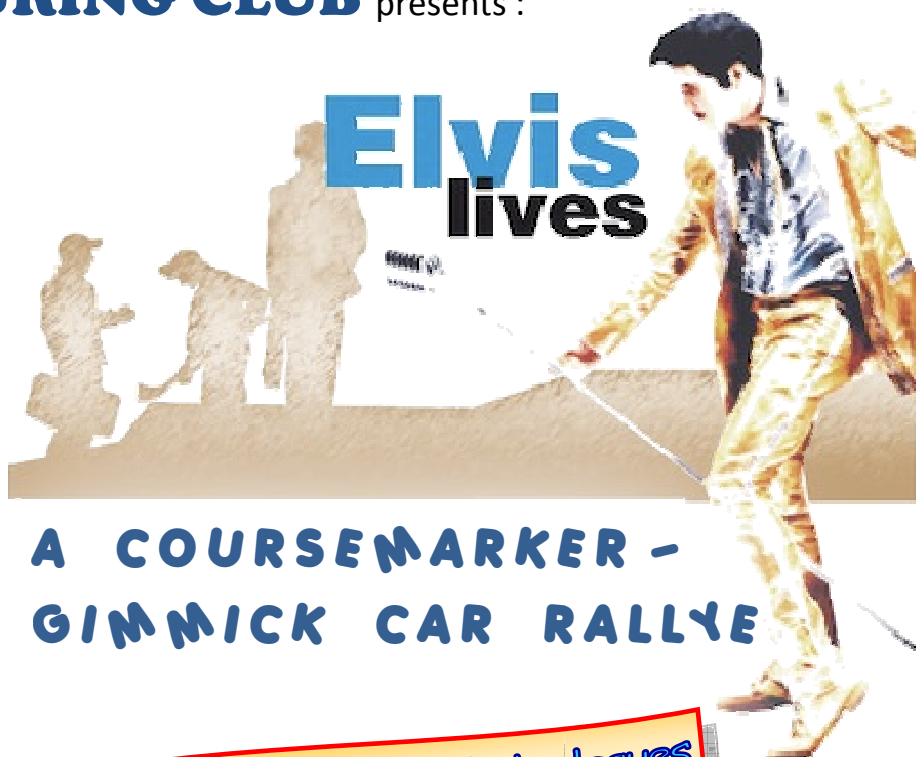

Entry Fee (per Carload): \$15

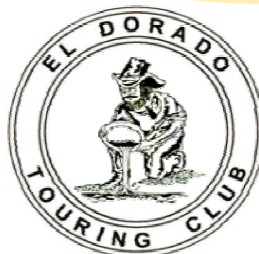
Awards in 6 classes: 1st Timer, Beginner, Novice, Senior, Expert, Master Expert
