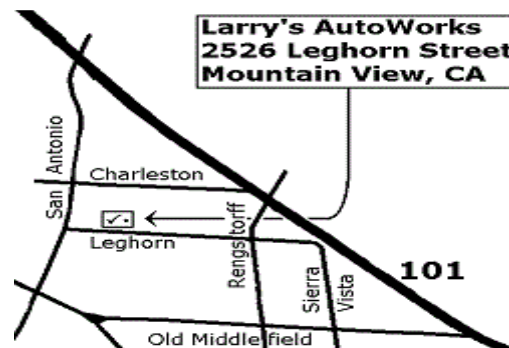
Starting between 3pm and 5pm at Larry's Auto Works
