We had an amazing 70 entries with 42 turning in scoresheets. Those 42 were from 8 states (CA, OR, ID, MD, PA, OH, IL, VA) plus the UK. This was TRC's first international event!

There were a few updates to the critique:

RI 8 could have been done at a Mathilda sign that we missed, at the corner of Washington and Pastoria. We adjusted allowed answers for Q6, Q7, and Q8 to account for this.

Q 10 about number of hours you could park was unclear if we were asking about starting or ending at 6:00 PM. We adjusted scoring to allow for either interpretation.

Q13's correct answer is ACE & anything or AAE & anything as the latter is the first three letters of the alphabetized correct street name, Taaffee.

The scores for a few participants were updated after the awards meeting, mostly from reviewing narrative answers to questions. Where the automatic scoring expected a blank answer, it didn't account for answers such as "I can't answer this question".

We made use of quite a bit of technology including Google Maps, Google Docs, Zoom, Zoho forms, email, and Jira Service Desk. Our one significant glitch was hitting a daily limit of email communications in Jira that we didn't know about, causing a number of you to not receive checkpoint slips. Fortunately, the impact of not reading the checkpoint slips was fairly small, but we know many of you lost time waiting for the information. We sincerely apologize for this issue.
