- 2 Congratulations to the entire group of rallyists who resisted the temptation to misuse the election process by voting multiple times at the checkpoint. Your honesty is certainly to be commended.
- 3 Scores After a review of the answers, a couple of the scores were adjust up. None of these changed the standings of the participants.
- 4 Awards The scores in the table show the awards for (P)=President and (V)=Vice President
- 5 Q 12 How many Stop(s) do you see?

Scoring for this Q was eliminated. The picture in Google maps did not match the reality I encountered after flying up to San Jose and running it myself. As always, last-minute patches never work, and can also cause problems elsewhere in the rallye.

Side Note: While I did miss the 'No' issue, please notice that it was in parentheses. As such, it could not be part of any trap.

6 Q 10 A vs Alberta

A was listed in the 'Answers...' document as the 'full credit' answer ***BUT*** having the entire name was listed as add-on credit. I broke this out to give credit to anyone who listed the entire name of any other roadway. What I did get wrong on the answer sheet was to show it as only worth one point. It was, however, listed as a full 10 points on the cheat-sheet I used for scoring the answers.

7 Q 10 Oak Point

Yes, I failed to mention that driving on sidewalks was forbidden. This also applies to the undefined pavement at the Start. I will add the following to my 'General' document:

Roadways

The default location for all travel is on a normal roadway. Unless specifically authorized by some item in the Order of Precedence, travel on anything else is not approved. Ramped concrete inside a curb is to be considered to be part of a driveway.

8 Q 3 This was a non-trap, needed to set up a future trap. There was an issue as to whether it referenced RI 15 or RI 14. It also may be that some people entered 'L' because they guessed that the obvious answer was wrong. I will add the following note to my 'General' document:

UnTraps:

It is sometimes find it useful for the answer to a Q to have no trap or to set up a trap in the instructions but not play it within the rallye. I reserve the right to do so. that I reserve the right to do so.

- 9 Q16 This was not scored. Again, due to a last minute change, I failed to update the number of questions on the Score Sheet. In the future, I will try to add extra g slots just to prevent this from happening.
- 10 Comments There were other 'suggestions for improvement' made about the rallye that are not referenced here. Part of the rallye process is to submit all final documentation to the rallye committee to be saved for future reference. These suggestions were not ignored, they are included in that documentation.
- Other Other comments were made regarding places where the rallye might have been improved. These are not addressed here, but are included in documentation of this rallye that is stored. If anyone references the
